***Lunch for the Week - \$25**

The Martin Luther H.S. cafeteria will provide lunch each day. The planned menu includes items such as bagel sandwiches, loaded nachos, PB&J, cheeseburgers, and personal-size pizza.

If you prefer, you are welcome to pack your own lunches for the week.

****Canteen - \$15 recommended**

Each afternoon, campers have an opportunity to buy snacks (candy, chips, soda, ice cream, etc.) from the Martin Luther H.S. concession stand. Canteen money is collected with registration and is deposited into their Canteen Account. Any remaining balance will be returned to the camper on the last day. We recommend \$15. Pay along with registration (include with your check). Returned balances will be in cash.

If your application is accepted, the \$60.00 registration fee is not refundable. There will be no refunds if you cancel less than two weeks before camp. (In the case of a Covid-19 related situation, contact the directors.) Your registration fee will be credited toward camp. To receive earlybird discount, the deposit is due anytime before May 1; the fee after May 1 is \$165. All balances must be paid in full by June 25, 2021. **Payment will not be accepted at check-in.**

COVID 19 - RELEASE

Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

Lutheran Band Camp (LBC) and The Lutheran High School Association of Greater Milwaukee (LHSAGM) have put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, LBC and the LHSAGM cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending any events associated with LBC could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending LBC events or activities and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at any LBC events or activities may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, LBC staff, volunteers, and program participants and their families either related to or not related to LBC.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at any LBC events or activities or participation in any LBC events or activities. On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless LBC and the LHSAGM, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from all Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. LHSAGM ELEMENTARY BAND COVID-19 GUIDELINES*

Staff and students will:

1. Maintain **social distance** of 6 feet whenever possible.
2. Wear **masks** when not playing.
3. Wear **playing masks** while playing:
 - a. Most instruments: Cut a small slit into a mask. (Teachers will help if needed.)
 - b. Flutes and Percussion: See below.
4. **Cover the bells** of their instruments:
Options:
 - a. Purchased bell cover.
 - b. Masks may be used for smaller instruments. Secure with hair tie/rubber band.
 - c. Large brass may use a towel or pillowcase. Secure with large rubber band.
5. Flute players:
 - a. Mask for your face – either a “flute mask” or a mask with extra space (to fit flute inside mask).
 - b. Cover the end of the flute with a mask/piece of cloth. Secure with hair tie.
6. Percussion players:
 - a. Wear masks during rehearsals.
 - b. Bring your own snare drum and sticks.
 - c. Wear gloves (provided for you) when sharing sticks, mallets, and other hand-held equipment.
7. Brass players:
 - a. **Bring a cloth** to catch any condensation.
8. Wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after playing.
9. Students may not handle another student’s instrument.

The directors may modify the above precautions as conditions change.
